The trainer is Global Citizenship Education Officer Anna Kivimäki from Taksvärkki ry. Taksvärkki ry (Operation a Day's Work Finland) is a Finnish NGO whose objective is to improve the living conditions and promote the human rights of children and young people in developing countries and to encourage Finnish young people towards global solidarity ([www.taksvarkki.fi](http://www.taksvarkki.fi)). Annually, Taksvärkki trains approx. 300 teachers on global citizenship education and children's rights.

The training will make use of Taksvärkki's two methodological handbooks:
